

United Stuns Olympic in 5-2 Rout

Tuggeranong United returned to form in stunning fashion on Sunday, smashing Canberra Olympic 5-2 at Woden Enclosed Oval to revive its top-four hopes.

After a dour first half, scores were locked at 0-0 and there was little warning that the match was about to open up.

But in its best 45 minutes of the season, Tuggeranong stunned the home side with five second half goals, including a well-deserved hat-trick to Dale Westmore and singles to Cale Padrotta and Mark Shields.

After a slow start to the season, Tuggeranong is suddenly back in the finals race with six points – less than two wins outside the top-four.

“It was a very good team effort with every single Tuggeranong player doing a brilliant job,” head coach Darren Viskovich said.

Tuggeranong’s next challenge is a tough one, as it faces last year’s premiers Belconnen United on Saturday.
